

TEGLA® Classic ZweiPlus is supplied in transportsafe wooden boxes with acid-free paper liners. In order to avoid humidity between the glass panels, the package is wrapped in plastic foil with a desiccant. After opening the foil, storage under low humidity is required.

Cleaning is done with commercial glass cleaners.

Caution: Do not use cleaners containing fluorides or hydroxides.
